

The monthly care level fee is based on the resident’s initial level of care assessment. A Registered Nurse will assess and assign a level of care. The level of care assessment is also used in planning the resident’s service plan. Re-evaluation of the resident’s level of care and service plan will occur on a regularly scheduled basis or upon a change in condition. The total Enhanced Assisted Living monthly statement is comprised of your studio rent, level of care package plus any à la carte charges.

Medication management: with outside pharmacy

EAL 1

Care assistance with all daily cares (ADLs) including meal setup and cueing, medication management and administration, one-person transfers, laundry (up to 4 loads) and personal emergency response device.

EAL 2

Care assistance with all daily cares (ADLs) including meal assistance, two-person transfers, medication management, continence management, nebulizer treatments, CPAP, wound management, one-person assistance with restorative cares, physical therapy recommendations, urinary catheter care, oxygen management, laundry (up to 4 loads) and personal pendant response device.

EAL 3

Care assistance with all daily cares (ADLs), medication management, diabetic management including sliding scale insulin, gastrostomy feedings, INR monitoring, mechanical lift transfers, wound management for two or more wounds, one-person assistance with restorative cares, physical therapy recommendations, palliative care or hospice care (working with contracted Medicare certified hospice), laundry (up to 4 loads) and personal pendant response device.

END OF LIFE PACKAGE

Care assistance to control pain and other symptoms. Includes turning, mouth cares and medication every two hours.
